HOUSE ATHLETICS CARNIVAL – Week 9

Due to the COVID-19 situation and the Government's maintenance of the Phase 4 restrictions, we have had to adjust how the carnival will run on the main day and essentially break the day into 3 events where only parents of those children competing will attend their respective timeslot and students will only be outside in their allotted timeslot. The house carnivals consist of events including running, throwing, jumping and catching so the students can showcase their talents after the many hours of training and practising as part of the physical education program here at school. The breakdown for the week is as follows:

Monday 14 September– Jumps, throws and long distance running events remain in place as scheduled and a program will be sent out detailing the approximate times for events.

Tuesday 15 and Thursday 17 September– These two days will be designated to respective Kindergarten groups to participate in their own mini carnival with a race and some novelty events. Parents will be invited to bring a picnic lunch at 1 pm and come and watch their child participate.

Wednesday 16 September- The House Carnival will remain in place with some adjustments to accommodate the 2 square metre rule for parents. Essentially the program will be staggered across the day as follows:


Year 2 – 3	8.40 – 10.00am

We have tried to spread the events and students on the day to help with this.




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A BIG THANK YOU TO THE LIONS CLUB ELLENBROOK


