Uniform Guidelines

- Hair longer than shoulder length should be tied up during school for safety and hygiene.
- Students can select school appropriate hair accessories for self-expression.
- Jewellery should be kept to a minimum for safety reasons.
- Make up is not permitted to be worn.
- Students are encouraged to wear sunscreen
- Students must wear the school uniform during school hours, including school excursions unless specified otherwise.
- Students are to always have access to a wide brimmed hat for outside play.
- Socks should be a standard size and colour.
- Non logo clothing can be worn if it is plain and navy coloured.
- Students need to wear enclosed shoes for safety at school.
- Smart watches that can be used to communicate should not be worn to school must be handed into the teacher at the start of the day.
